Winner will be encouraged to attend our local chapter luncheon on April 23 or May 28, 2025 in Champaign to be recognized and receive their award check.

Eligibility Requirements:

- 1. Be a high school senior, living or attending school within the boundaries of the ISPE Champaign County Chapter, which includes the counties of Champaign, Vermilion, Edgar, Douglas, Coles, Iroquois, and southern Ford.
- 2. Be a United States Citizen.
- 3. Have a minimum of 3.0 grade point average (based on a 4.0 grade scale).
- 4. Provide test score for SAT/ACT, or applicable reason for not taking.
- 5. Enroll in an engineering program at a college or university that has been accredited by the Engineering Accreditation Commission of the Accreditation Board of Engineering and Technology (ABET-EAC).

Assemble the application in the following order: (Do not use a report binder)

- 1. Application
- 2. Teacher Recommendations (at least two)
- 3. Employer Recommendation (optional)
- 4. Essay (maximum 500 words)
- 5. Official Transcripts (must be in a sealed and stamped envelope)
- 6. SAT and/or ACT scores (attach official score sheet if not included in the official transcript)

It is the responsibility of the applicant to see that complete information is submitted as required. Incomplete applications may not be considered. It is recommended that the applicant type the application, or use blue/black ink in legible writing. The overall appearance of the application may be considered in the scoring.
